



WOMEN IN PHILANTHROPY GRANTS 2009 – 2014

50 grants to 28 agencies totaling \$250,000

2009 TOTAL: \$ 10,000

\$4,500 Mercy Medical Clinic to provide quality dental care for needy clients.

\$4,500 The Naomi Project to increase community support and provide services to residents escaping domestic violence and abuse.

\$1,000 Dillon County Partnership 4 Kids to supply items (cribs, car seats, etc.) to keep children at home versus going into foster care.

2010 TOTAL: \$47,000

\$10,000 Lighthouse Ministries to teach effective parenting for mothers with small children.

\$6,000 Mercy in Me Free Medical Clinic for medical supplies and prescription expenses for uninsured people in Chesterfield County.

\$5,000.00 Florence Mercy Medicine Clinic to continue support for basic quality dental care for needy clients.

\$2,000.00 The Naomi Project to install an alarm system to monitor their safe house.

\$10,000.00 Pee Dee Coalition against Domestic and Sexual Assault for facility improvements and transportation costs for their Emergency Safe Shelter Program.

\$3,000.00 Senior Citizens Association – Florence County to provide light housekeeping, laundry services and shopping for senior citizens in the rural areas of Olanta, Timmonsville, Johnsonville and Pamplico.

\$10,000 Camp RAE to help cover costs of an educational and intensive therapy camp for multi-handicapped, non-mobile children.

\$1,000 McLeod Health Foundation for medication assistance for cancer patients.

2011 TOTAL: \$50,500

\$ 2,700 Girl Scouts of the Pee Dee for membership fees and equipment for new programs.

- **\$ 3,800 House of Hope** for kitchen up-dates.
- **\$ 4,200** Chrysalis Center of Circle Park for nutritional counseling and exercise equipment for their women's rehabilitation program.
- **\$ 4,400 Family Promise of Florence** to establish a program for homeless families.
- \$ 4,400 Harvest Hope Food Bank for nutritional support for seniors in Dillon County.
- **\$ 5,000 Pee Dee Speech & Hearing Center** for software to correct childhood speech problems.
- **\$ 6,000** Pee Dee Coalition against Domestic and Sexual Assault for counseling for children who have witnessed domestic abuse.
- **\$ 10,000 Camp Rae** to help cover costs of an educational and intensive therapy camp for multi-handicapped, non-mobile children.
- **\$ 10,000 PEK Foundation** for summer camp at East Florence Mission School.
- 2012 TOTAL: \$39,000
- **\$5,000.00 Mercy Medicine** for supplies and support to reduce costs of providing free dentures to qualified patients.
- **\$5,000.00 The Naomi Project** for general support for established safe house that offers protection and life skills to women in crisis.
- **\$4,000.00 House of Hope of the Pee Dee** for support for two weeks of operations for 30 50 residents at 2 facilities.
- **\$5,000.00 Harvest Hope Food Bank** to support a program that gives backpacks with food to children to provide meals for weekends. First in Florence area.
- **\$5,000.00 Lighthouse Ministries** to offer life skills education as well as diapers to young mothers in a 7 week course that teaches effective parenting and money management.
- **\$5,000.00** Mercy in Me Free Medical Clinic support for operations, medications, medical testing and supplies serving Chesterfield County.
- **\$2,500.00 Darlington County Council of Aging** to support their SMILE Program (Senior Meals in a loving environment) which provides 45,000 meals to the elderly.
- **\$2,500.00 Vital Aging of Williamsburg County** to offer assistance within the home to allow the continuing independence of senior citizens.
- **\$2,500.00 Boys and Girls Club of the Pee Dee Area** to support SMART GIRLS, a program that offers prevention, education, self-esteem enhancement over topics about dating violence, sexual assault, and conflict resolution.

\$2,500.00 Darlington County Free Medical Clinic support for providing medication and support for healthier outcomes from diabetes and or chronic hypertension.

2013 TOTAL: \$55,000

\$3,325.00 Vital Aging of Williamsburg County to provide transportation for senior citizens for meals and activities designed to keep them physically, emotionally, and spiritually fit.

\$7,000.00 Camp Rae of Florence to provide general operating support for a summer camp for wheelchair bound children with severe disabilities.

\$7,000.00 Sr. Citizens Association- Florence County to fund meals and planned activities to interact with others through arts and crafts, physical fitness, open discussions, and invited speakers.

\$7,000.00 Manna House in Florence to purchase food supplies and equipment upkeep for the service of 2 meals daily. The soup kitchen serves approximately 250 individuals a day.

Sample 24,325.00 Solution Darlington County Council of Aging to help provide over 45,000 meals to the elderly, as well as companionship to senior citizens in Darlington County.

\$3,600.00 Big Brothers/ Big Sisters in Florence to provide general operating support for activities that match single parent children with an adult that provides one-on-one quality time and mentoring.

Sp.,250.00 Darlington County First Steps to support a literacy program designed to engage parents to help their children learn to read as well as improve the literacy of a parent.

\$5,250.00 Bethlehem Stables Therapeutic Riding Program in Florence to fund the completion of required supplies to become an accredited PATH Center in order to work with Wounded Warriors.

\$5,250.00 Mercy In Me Free Medical Clinic, Chesterfield County, to provide operational and clinical support for a free medical clinic offering services.

\$7,000.00 Lighthouse Ministries in Florence to provide a seven-week course in effective parenting and money management for working mothers.

2014 TOTAL: \$53,000

\$7,000.00 Bethlehem Therapeutic Riding Stable, Florence, improves the lives of disabled children and adults through the use of equine therapy. The grant is for purchase of adaptive tack.

\$3,100.00 Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Pee Dee, Florence, provides "one to one" mentoring services to fatherless or single parent children. The grant will be used to pay for one week's worth of services.

\$7,000.00 Camp Rae, Florence, is a summer camp designed to improve the quality of life for children with multiple disabilities by providing comprehensive education and rehabilitation. The grant will cover operating expenses.

- **\$5,000.00 Caring and Sharing, Hemingway,** provides assistance to the disabled and low income elderly by furnishing food on a weekly basis. The grant will buy nonperishable food.
- **\$7,000.00 Help 4 Kids, Florence,** fills the weekend hunger gap for children in Florence County schools. The grant will buy food for their weekly distribution.
- **\$7,000.00 House of Hope, Florence,** provides safe housing, food, and clothing to the homeless. The grant will help expand the Men's facility, and be used for transportation and for 2 weeks support.
- **\$3,500.00 Marion County Habitat for Humanity, Marion County,** builds homes in the community and therefore hope. The grant will help build their 34th home.
- **\$5,000.00 Mercy Medicine Free Clinic, Florence,** provides free quality medical and dental care to low income and uninsured people. The grant is for "Give Back a Smile" which provides free dentures to help improve nutrition and boost confidence.
- **\$5,000.00** Pee Dee Speech and Hearing, Florence, provides audiology and speech pathology care. The grant will be used to purchase equipment to detect and treat hearing loss in infants.
- **\$3,400.00** Florence Open Tennis Tournament to benefit Susan G. Komen Foundation helps create a healthier community by encouraging exercise through tennis. The grant will support outreach services during the tournament including a mobile mammography unit on site to promote breast cancer awareness.
