



# FBi Construction Scholarship at Eastern Carolina Community Foundation Application must be submitted by March 31.

#### Purpose:

#### Qualifications:

- 1. Reside in one of the following counties: Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, Marlboro, or Williamsburg.
- 2. Be accepted to or enrolled at an accredited institution of higher education.
- 3. GPA must be 2.5 or better.
- 4. Demonstrate financial need. The applicant's FAFSA score is required.
- 5. Desire to pursue a degree or professional certificate in a construction related industry.

### **Application Process:**

  - A personal statement as described on page 2.
  - Your most recent official transcript of grades.
  - Proof of acceptance to or attendance at an institution of higher education technical school, college or university.
  - Provide 2 letters of reference from adults who are not family members that describe how you will succeed in the field of construction (forms are included.)
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Decisions made by the committee are final.
- 3. The scholarship is for tuition expenses and will be paid directly to the institution the student plans to attend, not to an individual.
