



# Jason Vance Chatlosh Memorial Scholarship at Eastern Carolina Community Foundation Application must be submitted by March 31.

The Jason Vance Chatlosh Memorial Scholarship was created in loving memory of Jason Vance Chatlosh to honor his vibrant competitive swimming career in the Pee Dee and in the state of South Carolina. The scholarship will keep Jason's swimming goals and dreams alive while helping students pursue their own college swimming and academic goals.

Jason began swimming at the age of five. At age twelve, he started to coach at the Florence YMCA. In 2004, he helped establish the Florence SD1 High School Swim Programs. Jason also swam for South Florence High School and earned state championships in the butterfly and backstroke. Jason continued his swimming career at Clemson, graduating with a degree in Parks, Recreation, and Tourism. He served as the swim team athletic representative on Clemson's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee.

<u>Purpose:</u> To provide a \$1,000 scholarship to a student swimmer to continue their swimming career in college.

#### **Qualifications:**

- 1. Reside in one of the following counties: Sumter, Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, Marlboro, or Williamsburg.
- 2. Be accepted to or enrolled at an accredited institution of higher education.
- 3. Swim at the college level for a college team.

#### **Application process:**

- The applicant must return a complete application by mail to Eastern Carolina Community Foundation, PO Box 1615, Florence, SC 29503 or by email to info@easterncarolinacf.org by March 31 with:
  - A personal statement as described on page 2.
  - Your most recent official transcript of grades.
  - Proof of acceptance to or attendance at an accredited institution of higher education.
  - 2 letters of reference from adults who are not family members (forms are included.)
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Decisions made by the committee are final.
- 3. The scholarship is for tuition expenses and will be paid directly to the institution the student plans to attend, not to an individual.
