Application must be submitted by March 31.

This scholarship was established in memory of Michelle Yolanda Glenn Carey who dedicated twenty years to the teaching of kindergarten students at Theodore Lester Elementary School in Florence, SC. Her teaching career extended to the children of her first students. Michelle believed in continuing to learn and was always ready, willing, and able to pursue educational opportunities. Anyone who had the pleasure of meeting her, being taught by her, or working with her, knew she was on a mission to teach with passion and a smile.

The person who receives this scholarship has a great legacy to uphold while changing the lives of the ones whom they are privileged to teach.

Purpose: To provide a \$500 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who finished their elementary education at Theodore Lester Elementary School and has a desire to teach elementary education.

Qualifications:

1. Reside in one of the following Pee Dee counties: Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Marion, Marlboro, or Williamsburg.
2. An individual who has as a goal to pursue a degree in elementary education and teach in elementary school.
3. Demonstrate caring, a true desire to help others, cheerfulness, volunteerism, follow through and compassion for children and others.

Process:

1. The applicant must return an application by mail to Eastern Carolina Community Foundation, PO Box 1615, Florence, SC 29503 or by email to info@easterncarolinacf.org by **March 31** with:
 - A personal statement as described on page 2.
 - Your most recent official transcript of grades.
 - Proof of acceptance to an institution of higher education.
 - 2 letters of reference from adults who are not family members.
2. **Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.** Decisions made by the committee are final.
3. The scholarship is for tuition expenses and will be paid directly to the institution where the student plans to attend, not to an individual.
